

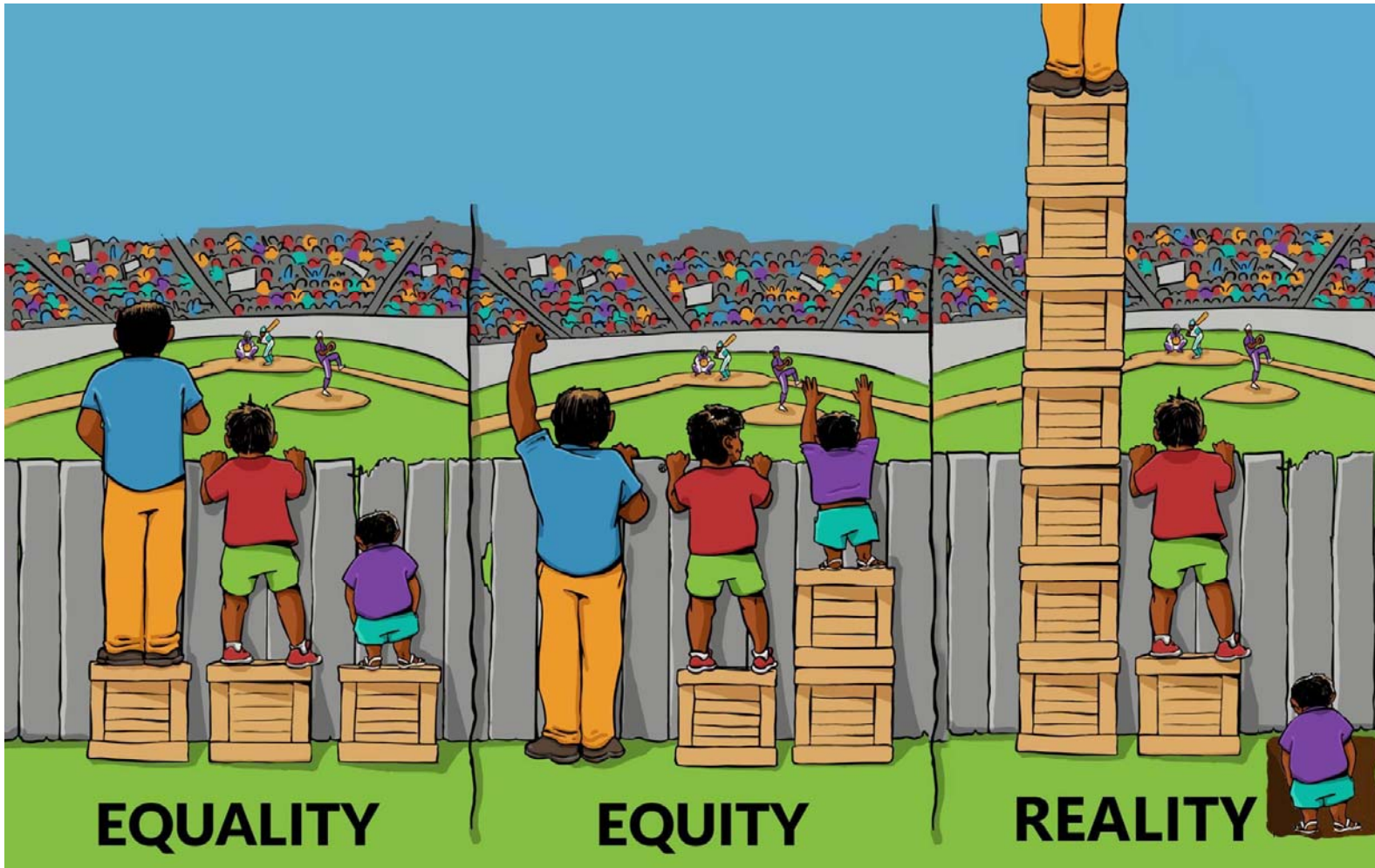

“People-powered”



“Creating a people-centred intervention system”

“ [so that the treatment may] protect and enhance their mana and dignity”

How will we do it?

- ▶ “Co-design the problems, not just the solutions”
- ▶ Rigor on data, but “lots of heart”
- ▶ Work with people with lived experience
- ▶ Work with communities, especially Māori, Pacific and Asian

What are we thinking about?

We want to try things:

- ▶ community mobilisation?
- ▶ peer support?
- ▶ training 'non-health' community services/people to deliver screening?
- ▶ Ways to deliver services in rural areas?

We hope our pilot kaupapa Māori and Pacific service in Waikato will be an exemplar.
